

Dear parents/carers,

As you are aware, Murrayfield, along with all schools in England, will be closed at the end of the school day until further notice for the vast majority of pupils. We will be open, in line with government direction, to children of key workers and/or vulnerable children.

We are preparing a packed lunch, each day, for all pupils in reception, year 1 and year 2 and for pupils who receive a free school meal in years 3 to 6. These will be available for collection between 11:30 and 12:30 in the Key Stage 1 playground.

Home learning packs have gone home with pupils over the last two days; if you have not received a pack, these can be collected from school. We will be creating additional activities and packs which will be available over the coming days; we will notify you of when these are ready and when to return your child's completed work so it can be marked. These packs will include new learning as well as consolidation and revision of what pupils have covered so far this year.

School will be staffed throughout the coming weeks but we ask that, if at all possible, contact is made via telephone and email rather than in person.

We will continue to communicate and update you through ParentMail, our website, Twitter and Facebook so please check these channels every couple of days.
